Why Do We Do That?

CENTERS & SPACES (Part 1)

“Liturgical centers. Liturgical centers are focal points where specific liturgical actions take place. For Mass, the liturgical centers are three: the *altar*, of course; the *presider's chair*, and the *ambo*, a word derived from the Greek word meaning “reading table,” which is the place from where the Scriptures are proclaimed as well as possibly the responsorial psalm, homily, and prayer of the faithful (see GIRM 309). When baptisms take place, the *baptismal font* is a liturgical center. In a cathedral there is the *cathedra* (from the Greek meaning “chair”), the special chair for the bishop, his “seat of authority.””
