

LENTEN BOOK CLUB

Lent is a time of increased prayer and growth in our faith. Why Do We Do That?

CENTERS & SPACES (Part 2)

"Sacred spaces. Any church building has a number of separate spaces designed for specific purposes. The *sanctuary*, while perhaps not so clearly set off as before the council, nonetheless is its own space. The sanctuary is the space enveloping the altar, ambo and presider's chair and those who minister at these liturgical centers. Nothing ought to get in the way of the sight lines to these liturgical centers. The *nave* is the assembly space and is generally the largest sacred space. The *narthex* is the entrance or gathering space where the hospitality ministers greet those coming to liturgy, where the baptismal font may be placed, and leads to the name. The *reconciliation room* is a sacred space where the sacrament of penance is celebrated with the individual; it is larger than the familiar confessional boxes in older churches and permits face-to-face confession. There may be a separate *Blessed Sacrament* chapel where the sacrament is reserved in the tabernacle (a locked and immovable receptacle; see GIRM 314) for Communion for the sick and homebound, for *Viaticum* (Holy Communion for the dying), and for adoration. There may be separate *devotional spaces* with statues or sacred art that promote veneration of the saints and further people's devotional life. A practical space is the *sacristy* and sometimes separate *vesting room*, usually off the sanctuary space and sometimes near the narthex where the entrance procession would begin; here, the ministers vest, and vestments and other things needed for liturgy are stored."






