**Pope Francis  
and  
St Anthony of Padua**

**The Saint of Lost Things is helping people find their way to The Lord**

“Relics are parts of the body of a saint who was the Temple of the Holy Spirit.”  
**Pope Francis**

St Francis of Assisi and Pope Francis have an important friend in common – he is St Anthony of Padua, the much loved 13<sup>th</sup> century friar who was one of the earliest members of the Franciscan Order which was founded in 1209.

When Pope Francis was Archbishop Jorge Bergoglio of Buenos Aires, he led a prominent procession through the streets of the Argentinian capital in the year 2000, carrying in his hands a reliquary containing a precious relic of St Anthony of Padua – a piece of his floating rib.

On June 15, St Anthony will be visiting Saint Barbara Roman Catholic Church in Massillon, in the form of two relics. One relic is a fragment of his floating rib while the second relic is skin of his cheek. Sister Lucy, one of the three seers of Fatima, venerated the relics in 1995 in her convent in Coimbra, Portugal on the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the saint’s birth.

This relic will be accompanied by Father Mario Conte, a Franciscan Friar from Padua, Italy where the Saint is buried. According to Fr Mario Conte, who is Editor of the *Messenger of St Anthony*, “*There is nothing superstitious about relics. The real meaning of a relic is love – they are a link of love between the person who venerates and the saint.*” *St Anthony intercedes with those trying to find a job, a home, faith, love, hope and mercy.*

In an address in Cologne, Germany, Thursday, August 18, 2005, Pope Benedict Emeritus said of relics “By inviting us to venerate the mortal remains of the martyrs and saints, the Church does not forget that, in the end, these are indeed just human bones, but they are bones that belonged to individuals touched by the living power of God. The relics of the saints are traces of that invisible but real presence which sheds light upon the shadows of the world and reveals the Kingdom of Heaven in our midst.”

Please join Pastor Brian Cline on Friday, June 15, for Holy Masses with veneration of precious relics at Saint Barbara Church. Prayer petitions with holy cards will be distributed by Friar Mario Conte and volunteers to allow parishioners to write their prayer petition to the saint. The writing of a prayer petition is a worldwide tradition when venerating a relic of a saint. Father Conte will bring the petitions back to the Pontifical Basilica in Padua and place them at the tomb of Saint Anthony. The tour officially ends back at the Tomb of Saint Anthony where the Friars will gather to pray for the saint’s intercession upon our intentions and petitions.
