

Students are eligible to maintain their scholarship through high school as long as they meet the requirements for renewal. To be eligible to apply the first time, the total household income must be at or below these incomes.

Have you heard of Ohio's EdChoice and EdChoice Expansion Scholarship Program? Ohio is one of only fourteen states offering a tuition voucher program enabling parents, whose children attend public schools, to switch to a participating private or parochial school. In other words, the voucher pays for private or parochial school tuition instead of the parents.

As parents, we are responsible for seeking the best educational placement for our children. Afterall, our children spend a considerable amount of time in schools and educational institutions are a primary influencer on their future success. However, not all schools are the correct fit for every student.

Ohio's EdChoice programs provides an opportunity for parents to choose alternative school placements for their children. Whether you are concerned about academic achievement, safety, discipline, bullying or seek a faith-based education, the EdChoice program allows parents more autonomy to choose the best school for their children.

There are two ways families can qualify for Ohio's EdChoice Scholarship program:

- 1. If your child attends a public school that is designated by the Ohio Department of Education as an underperforming public school.
- 2. If your family meets a qualifying income requirement.


