Donna DeBlasio is Professor of History and Director of the Center for Applied History at Youngstown State University. She received her BA and MA in history from Youngstown State and Ph.D. from Kent State University. For nearly fifteen years, she worked as a museum site manager and historian for the Ohio Historical Society and the Ohio Historic Preservation Office. Dr. DeBlasio came to YSU in 1999, after leaving her position as Senior Historian for the Cincinnati Museum Center. In 2016, she became the editor of *Ohio History*.
