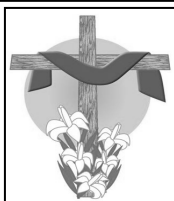

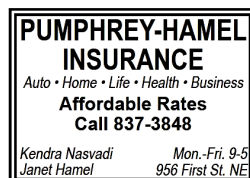
40 Days for Life 2019 Public Prayer Vigil
