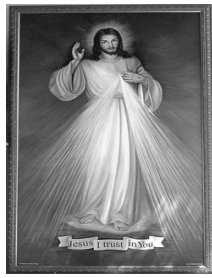

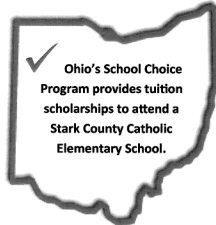

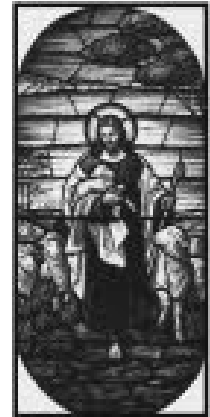
**Marked By Faith (Ages 21 to 39)**
