A Note from Fr. Matthew

Imprisoned spirits, crippled emotions

We tried to make that difficult call to at least begin healing the rift with an estranged relative or friend, but we stop, "crippled" by our fear of being rebuffed.



We wanted to offer our support to the coworker who just lost his or her job, but we are "bent down" with anxiety and fear about keeping our own jobs.

We want to be there for our families, we want to give our time and energy to causes and projects we believe in, but, ironically, we are "bound" by our over-scheduled calendars and endless lists of things we just have to do that we barely make it through the day.

We're "crippled" by our jealousy of someone who's gotten a break that we should have gotten or our anger at someone who got ahead at our expense.

We're unable to "stand straight," weighed down by our constant worry for a son or daughter who doesn't do things the way we would do them or who hasn't realized the promise we had hoped for them or isn't calling as often as we'd like.

We're "bent over" with dread because of some medical condition, an unshakable anxiety over finances, or overwhelming grief at the loss of a loved one.

Imprisonment is not just a place but a state of mind; one can be "crippled" not only physically but spiritually and emotionally; we can be "bent over" and unable to stand straight because of any number of burdens, real or imagined.

And those can be more difficult prisons and challenges to free ourselves from.

In his healing of the crippled woman on the Sabbath, Jesus calls us to realize the attitudes that imprison us and the fears that "cripple" us from embracing the love of God in our lives. Like the woman in today's Gospel who is "crippled by a spirit," we are all "bound" by some infirmity that leaves us "incapable of standing erect." So let Jesus lay his hand upon us, as he lays his hand upon the crippled woman, and walk unbowed in the grace of God that enables us to put aside our crippling anger to rebuild the broken relationship; to overlook the failings of others, aware of our own mistakes; to embrace the hope that comes in imitating the humble servanthood of Christ.


