Stewardship: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." MATTHEW 5:3

The phrase "poor in spirit" can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God's providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthy things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). Denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.

A Note from Fr. Matthew

"People of the earth"

Farmers and gardeners will all tell you: Humus is the gold in their fields and gardens. Composed of the decay of plant and animal matter, humus is the

most organic and richest part of the soil. When it is tilled and broken open to receive seed and rainfall and sunlight, the dark humus soil yields the most bountiful harvests and the most beautiful of flowers.

The word humility comes from the same root as humus. Like the rich, broken soil of humus, humility is the capacity to be open to receive the seeds of experience — both the painful and the enriching — in order to grow in wisdom and understanding. Humility is the grace to let ourselves be "broken" — broken of our pride, our ego — in order to realize a harvest far greater than ourselves, a harvest that is possible only through generous openness, selfless giving and enlightened gratitude.

Humility is the grace to plant in hope, to persevere through droughts and storms and reap in joy.


