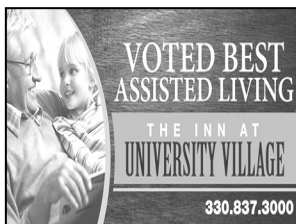

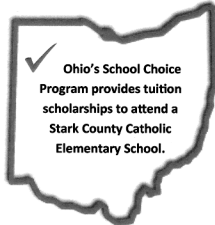

Scholarships for up to \$4,650 for children attending public schools designated by the State of Ohio.

EdChoice Expansion Scholarship:

Income based scholarships for up to \$4,650.

First Time Applicants – scholarships can be used for children entering Kindergarten through 6th grade in the 2019-20 school year. Students are eligible to maintain their scholarship through high school as long as they meet the requirements for renewal.
