Natural Family Planning Classes

Mercy Medical Center offers Natural Family Planning Classes for interested couples. The next class series will begin on Sunday, October 13th from 2-4pm. All Classes are taught by certified teaching couples. The fee for the class series is \$40.00 per couple, which includes all materials and parish is free. This service is offered in cooperation and under the guidance of the Office of Marriage and Family Ministry of the Catholic Diocese of Youngstown. Natural Family Planning (NFP) is the knowledge and understanding of natural fertility. It is acceptance and respect for combined fertility as a couple.

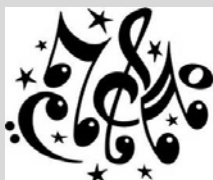
