

**Stewardship:** "No servant can serve two masters. He will hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. ou cannot serve God and mammon (wealth)." Luke 16:13

Jesus knows that for many of us, God and money run "neck and neck" as top priority. Is money a "god" that you put before God? Giving money to support the Church and other charity is a pillar of our faith, just like attending Mass every Sunday and participating in parish ministry. Giving money frees us from becoming a slave to money. It increases our dependence on God and our trust that God will provide all that we need.

#### A Note from Fr. Matthew

#### A parable of crisis

You're fired. Turn in your keys and hand in your password.

We need to talk about the lab results.

Your son has been arrested for DWI.

Her curfew was two hours ago and she's not home yet.

Crisis — an unexpected event that demands immediate action. In Greek, the word "crisis" means "judgment." The Chinese call a crisis "a dangerous opportunity."

It's in times of crisis, we decide what sort of person we are.

In terms of today's Gospel, the question becomes: Who will we serve?

How will we respond to this mess not of our making — or are we able to face our responsibility to fix what we have broken?

Can we move beyond the injustice and unfairness to a new challenge?

Are we able to check our own emotions to be there for our loved one?

Is our first concern for another's safety before demanding accountability?

Is it possible for us to put aside our justified anger for the sake of finding a solution for the good of all?

Our ability to respond to life's crises with creativity and understanding, with grace and generosity, depends on the principles we live every day: Are we "children of light" — or "dishonest" stewards?

Are we "prudent" in our use of resources — or do we seek to grab as much as we can get away with? Do we act with integrity, taking seriously what is means to be a disciple Jesus — or do we seek the approval of the "master" who holds the fate of our career advancement and social status in his or her hands?

Do we serve God — or self?

In times of crisis, we have to choose one or the other.

The parable of the dishonest manager begins in crisis: the steward has just lost his job. He acts "prudently" in the eyes of his master – he dodges the bullet for the moment. But while those of us who have been in similar situations understand the steward's actions, we've learned, too, that pride and avarice are a toxic mix. Today's confronts us with how we respond to the crises we face in our lives: getting to the root of the problem instead of the "quick," painless fix; being concerned first with the impact of this situation on others and not just the repercussions on us alone; responding with care and compassion for the safety of those fail us, putting aside our own (often justifiable) anger to restore and repair our relationship with them. Jesus calls us to act as "children of light," to take on life's challenges with honesty, to place people before profit, to "serve" what is good and of God.


