Updates Regarding Mass:

As of Monday, May 25th, 2020, we have been given permission to begin having Masses in person, again. We will resume daily Masses on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings at 9:00 am. At that time, we will begin to live stream Masses on Facebook. Our first regular weekend Masses will take place the weekend of May 30th and 31st with the celebration of Pentecost. More details to follow in the coming weeks.

*Please note that Bishop Murry has dispensed Catholics from attending Sunday Masses for the foreseeable future. We will communicate any changes as we receive information. Parishioners of advanced age or with underlying medical problems, or parishioners who are ill are all encouraged to stay home.

Adoration:

We will not begin all day adoration as of yet. However, we will have adoration for one hour immediately following Mass on Tuesday mornings beginning June 2nd, 2020.

Sacraments of Initiation:

The diocese has asked that we wait to schedule any sacraments of initiation (i.e. First Holy Communion and Confirmation) until after July 1st, 2020. As we receive communication on this, we will keep you all informed. Baptisms will be done privately outside of Mass for the foreseeable future and should be scheduled with Amy Davis at the parish office.
